Included Items:

Item	Description	Quantity
Stone Abacus	Play Equipment	1
Hardware	3/8" x 2-3/4" Button Head Bolt	6
Hardware	3/8" Flat Washer	12
Hardware	3/8" Lock Washer	6
Hardware	3/8" Lock Nut	6

If you determine that less than 12" of surfacing is required, make sure the top of the concrete slab is 12" below the top of the protective surfacing.


NOTE: Read installation instructions thoroughly before starting installation process.

Step 1: Lay out the area and prepare the site for install. Concrete must be installed over a solid, level base. Check local soil condition and codes.

Step 2: Refer to the typical in-ground footing detail on excavating a hole for the component.


Step 3: Place the component into the excavated footing. Using hardware kit provided, bolt the 3 stainless pipes to posts (6 places). Temporarily brace when level and plumb. Pour the concrete footing. The concrete should be flush with the ground level, as shown in the typical in-ground footing detail. Allow time for the concrete to cure completely before continuing.

Step 4: Remove temporary bracing. Unbolt the pipes from the posts and slide on 11 spacers and 10 stones on each pipe (3 pipes total). Ensure there is a spacer between every stone. Reattach the pipes with the provided hardware.
