





## Installation Instructions

**NOTE: Read installation instructions thoroughly before starting installation process.**

**Step 1:** Lay out the area and prepare the site for install. Concrete must be installed over a solid, level base. Check local soil condition and codes. See Switchback Rock Climber installation instructions for minimum use zone requirements to ensure proper spacing and adequate surfacing area.

**Step 2:** Pour a concrete base for the Switchback Rock Climber. Refer to the typical slab section on the typical footing page of the Switchback Rock Climber installation instructions. The concrete should be flush with the ground level. Allow time for the concrete to completely cure before continuing.

**Step 3:** Using an appropriate lull-type forklift or boom, place Switchback Rock Climber with Slide Attachment into final installation location. See the hardware recommendation page for information on anchoring equipment down to your slab. Refer to the surfacing manufacturer for installation of an approved impact attenuating play surface around the Switchback Rock Climber with a minimum of 6 feet in every direction.

**Step 4:** Attach the slide deck enclosure to the Switchback Rock Climber using hardware kit 8-01 (4 places).


**Step 5:** Assemble the slide and prepare footing holes per the slide manufacturer's instructions.

**Step 6:** Attach the slide to the slide deck enclosure using hardware kit 8-02 (2 places) and hardware kit 8-03 (4 places).


**Step 7:** Pour the concrete footers for the slide supports, per the slide manufacturer's instructions.

### NOTES PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION:


- Use appropriate equipment to lift and move the play equipment.
- Check local codes and requirements prior to digging or installing any equipment.



## Installation Instructions



**Step 4:** Attach the slide deck enclosure to the Switchback Rock Climber using hardware kit 8-01 (4 places).



**Step 6:** Attach the slide to the slide deck enclosure using Hardware kits 8-02 & 8-03.





3/8" NYLOCK LOCK NUT, SS	X4

## Installation Instructions


**Step 8:** Locate your anchor bolts, supplied by Cre8Play. Using the proper standard drill bit size noted in the installation table, drill the concrete to the appropriate hole depth (C).

**Step 9:** Insert the anchor bolt into the hole and tighten until the bolt is fully seated. Do NOT over tighten the anchor bolts.




**Anchor Bolt (Large Diameter Tapcon)  
Installation:**




Mounting Detail
